

## CRU Manifesto & Presidential Debate



## CRU Chapel Multi-Million Revamp

In a bid to catch the full attention of the young worshipers and to give its mode of worship a facelift, the Chaplaincy has invested heavily on easy worship gadgets in the Chapel.

The gap between those on the platform and those at the rear end of the auditorium has been bridged. They have been brought closer with the use of two smart camera with 360 degree rotation hung to the ceiling, which would transmit pictures directly to a 65 inch Smart LED Flat Screen hung to the ceiling at the centre back of the stage and six other 52 inch Smart LED Flat Screen hung to the ceiling at strategic places in the hall. New Loud speakers were also bought to provide good and quality sound.

As a result these gadget/facilities boost the morale of the students, as they not only attend the revamped Chapel for their services, but now, participate actively by singing hymns and reading Bible passages from the Flat Screen during services.
