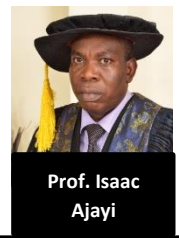
JAMB Registration Kicks off in Crawford

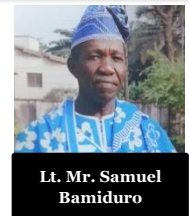
